

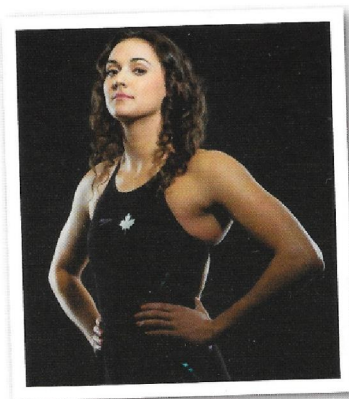
Windsor Essex Swim Team: Home of 2016 Olympian Kylie Masse

The Windsor Essex Swim Team (WEST) finished the 2015-2016 season with some tremendous results:

- Kylie Masse is going to the Olympics in Rio ranked #2 in the world in the 100-metre backstroke with a Canadian record of 59.06 seconds.
- Two WEST swimmers qualified for the 2016 FINA World Championships in Windsor.
- At the Ontario Provincial Team Championships, our team finished in 4th place in a very close race for the podium.
- Our junior program won its 7th consecutive St. Clair-Erie Aquatic League Championships with nine individual trophy winners.
- Our Stroke Development Program, for children 5 to 12-years-old, offers six different programs from beginner to competitive levels.
- 42 WEST athletes qualified for Ontario Provincial Competitions and 12 of them came back with gold medals.
- Our Masters swimmers continue a legacy of success with medal performances at the Ontario Provincials, Canadian Nationals and Michigan State Championships.
- The Masters program runs from September until August and includes swimmers of all ability levels, right from beginner to World Champion medalists.
